

# Initial Occupational First Aid (SST) Training

**Prerequisites :** None

**Target Audience :** This training is intended for all employees, regardless of their position or sector of activity, who may be designated as Occupational First Aiders (SST) within their company.

## Course Objectives :

**Upon successful completion of the training, participants will be able to :**

- Take preventive measures to reduce workplace accident risks.
- Protect themselves, the victim and others.
- Assess the victim's condition using the SST methodology.
- Raise the alarm and communicate effectively with emergency services.
- Provide appropriate first aid until professional help arrives.
- Use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED).
- Identify hazardous situations within the workplace.
- Contribute to occupational risk prevention.
- Understand their role within the company's Health & Safety organisation.

The course combines theory and extensive practical exercises, including:

- Interactive presentations.
- Demonstrations by experienced instructors.

## COURSE PROGRAMME :

### Module 1 – The Role of the Occupational First Aider (SST)

- Legal framework, Employer responsibilities.
- Responsibilities of the Occupational First Aider.
- Occupational risk prevention. Position of the SST within the company's emergency organisation.

### Module 2 – Protecting the Scene

- Hazard identification. Scene safety. Victim protection.
- Personal safety. Prevention of secondary accidents.

### Module 3 – Casualty Assessment

- Primary assessment. Identification of life-threatening emergencies. Recognition of warning signs.
- Prioritisation of emergency actions.

### Module 4 – Raising the Alarm

- Internal emergency procedures. Contacting emergency services. Delivering a complete emergency message. Coordination with emergency responders.

### Module 5 – Emergency First Aid

Practical management of:

- Severe bleeding. Choking. Medical emergencies. Burns. Wounds. Musculoskeletal injuries. Unconscious casualty breathing normally. Cardiac arrest (CPR).

### Module 6 – Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

- Recognition of cardiac arrest. Safe operation of the AED. Electrode pad placement. CPR coordination. AED safety procedures.

### Module 7 – Occupational Risk Prevention

- Hazard identification. Reporting unsafe situations. Risk prevention. Continuous improvement of workplace safety. Company-specific occupational hazards.

### Module 8 – Practical Scenarios

- Realistic workplace simulations. Company-specific scenarios. Practical application of first aid skills. Teamwork during emergency response.

## Teaching Methods and Resources

## ASSESSMENT

Participants are assessed continuously throughout the course.

- Certification includes:
  - Practical emergency response scenarios.
  - Assessment of occupational prevention competencies.
  - Continuous observation by the instructor.
